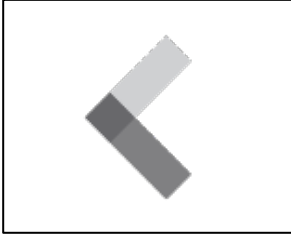

FROM DOUBT TO WONDER: Embracing the Loss of Everything You Thought You Knew

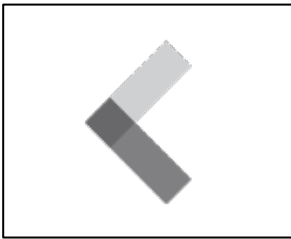

SHADOWS OF OUR FUTURE SELVES

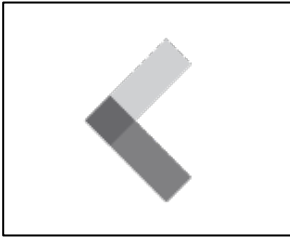

Now, two thousand years later, we face similar challenges. In a commodified, achievement-oriented economy, we are no longer valued for ourselves and become anxious. And in the world of social media, which inundates us with information but undermines the deepest kinds of knowing and being known, we become lonely, even as our "connections" multiply. But these problems have surprisingly ancient roots—and remedies.

In this thought-provoking and wholly original book, Andy Crouch draws on history and contemporary examples to show how Christians can recapture the essence of their faith to meet the challenges of modern life.

IN A DARK WOOD: *My Five-Year War with a Disease that Doesn't Exist*

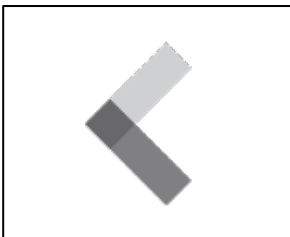

The *New York Times* columnist tells the story of his five-year struggle with Lyme disease, exploring how his search for healing brought him face-to-face with the limits of modern medicine and the narratives we tell ourselves in order to live.

In the summer of 2015, Ross Douhat acquired a mysterious, devastating sickness that left him sleepless, crippled, wracked with pain. After months seeing doctors without result, he discovered that he had a disease that according to existing CDC definitions does not actually exist—the chronic, persistent form of Lyme disease, that has no official recognition and no medically approved cure.

IN A DARK WOOD is a story about what happens when you are terribly sick and realize that even the doctors who are willing to treat you can only do so much. Along the way, Douhat describes his struggle to survive with humor and candor, portraying sickness as the most terrible of gifts. It teaches you to appreciate the grace of ordinary life by taking that life away from you. It reveals the deep strangeness of the world, the possibility that the reasonable people might be wrong, and the necessity of figuring out things for yourself. And it proves, day by dreadful day, that you are stronger than you ever imagined, by planting you deep in hell and giving you no choice except to climb back out.

Ross Douhat joined *The New York Times* as an Op-Ed columnist in April 2009 and he co-hosts the *Times'* Op-Ed podcast, "The Argument." Previously, he was a senior editor at The Atlantic and a blogger on its website. He is the author of *THE DECADENT SOCIETY, TO CHANGE THE CHURCH, BAD RELIGION,* and *PRIVILEGE*, and a co-author, with Reihan Salam, of *GRAND NEW PARTY*.

Patrick Boland is a member of the CAC community who consults directly with Richard Rohr on a number of projects, including the study guides to THE UNIVERSAL CHRIST and the upcoming FALLING UPWARD online courses. He is a psychotherapist and an executive coach, with an emphasis on team dynamics and integrated spirituality.

Pope Francis is the first Latin American to be elected to the chair of Peter. Born Jorge Mario Bergoglio in Buenos Aires, Argentina, he was ordained as a priest in 1969. He served as head of the Society of Jesus in Argentina from 1973 to 1979. In 1998 he became the archbishop of Buenos Aires, and in 2001 a cardinal. Following the resignation of his predecessor, Pope Benedict XVI, on February 28, 2013, the conclave elected Bergoglio, who chose the papal name Francis in honor of Saint Francis of Assisi.

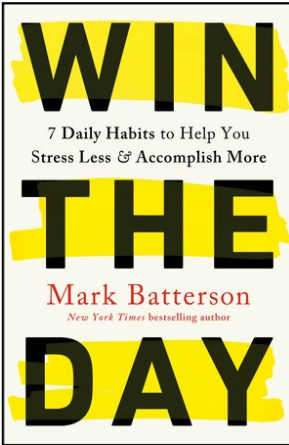

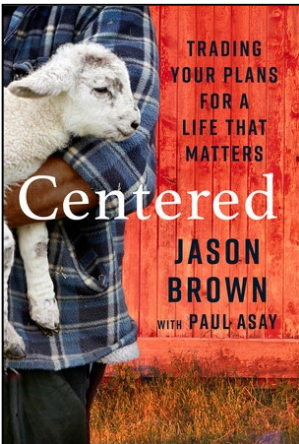

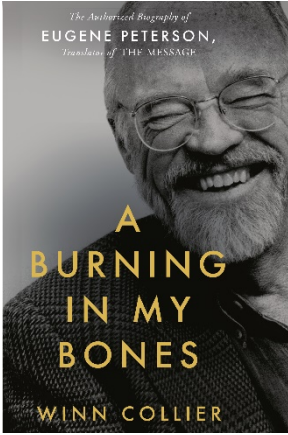

But through third-party mismanagement and bad luck, Jason lost most of his savings from the NFL—the same money he'd planned to use to start his new career. Today, Jason and his family run First Fruits Farms in Louisburg, North Carolina, a state where one in four children don't know where their next meal will come from. Since 2014, the Browns have donated more than 1.6 million servings of fresh produce to their community. Their motto: Never stop giving. Never stop loving. Never stop growing. With powerful and deeply personal insight, **CENTERED** is an inspiration to embrace the joy of following where God leads—no matter how crazy it sounds.

Jason Brown grew up in Henderson, North Carolina. He went on to attend the University of North Carolina, where he played both guard and tackle before moving to center. He never missed a game. He was drafted in the fourth round by the Baltimore Ravens in 2005. Brown became a free agent in 2009 and was signed by the St. Louis Rams for \$37.5 million, making him the highest-paid center in the league. He was again a free agent three years later, but rather than signing a new contract, Brown left the NFL and bought a 1,000-acre farm nearly Louisburg, North Carolina. Brown has been farming full-time since 2013, and he gives nearly everything that he grows (mostly sweet potatoes) to the poor.

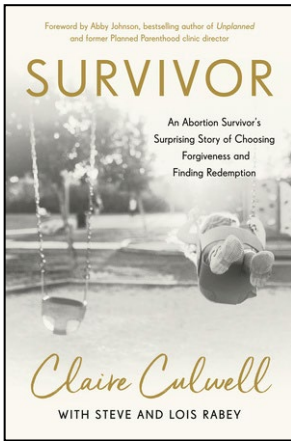

SURVIVOR: An Abortion Survivor's Surprising Story of Choosing Forgiveness and Finding Redemption

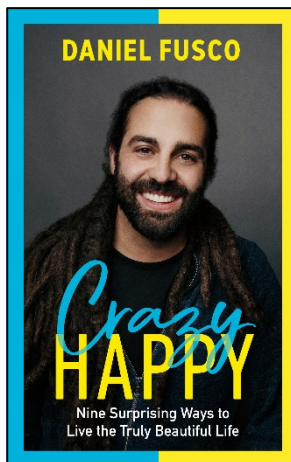
