With the recent resurgence of classics and the increased interest in picture books due to the global pandemic, THE CROWS OF PEARBLOSSOM should soar to the top of the list of prospective titles to publish. Written by the great Aldous Huxley in 1944, THE CROWS OF PEARBLOSSOM was given to his niece as a Christmas gift and is the only children's story he ever wrote.

In the tradition of *Aesop's Fables*, this is the wonderful (albeit slightly dark) story of Mr. and Mrs. Crow, who live in a cottonwood tree. The hungry Rattlesnake that lives at the bottom of the tree has a nasty habit of stealing Mrs. Crow's eggs before they can hatch, so Mr. Crow and his wise friend, Old Man Owl, devise a sneaky plan to trick him. Although it can be read on many levels, this story shares a terrific message: Personal ingenuity and intelligence always triumph over brute strength.

We represent the text for THE CROWS OF PEARBLOSSOM and publishers are free to commission their own illustrations, or can license the illustrations of another foreign edition. Besides the US/UK (which features charming illustrations by Caldecott-Winner, Sophie Blackall), THE CROWS OF PEARBLOSSOM has been most successful in Brazil, France (illustrations by awardwinning, Beatrice Alemagna), Germany and Spain, where it continues to sell well, year after year.



If they succeed, he promises to tell Finn where his father is. He even gives them a pair of time-traveling pajamas to help them with their quest. There's only one problem: The pajamas malfunction almost immediately. While trying to fix the faulty pajamas, the kids run into even more trouble-- hungry sabretooths and a town full of holograms. Just when their goal is in sight, Julep gets sick although it doesn't seem like she's sick. It seems like she's *changing*. This adventure may cost Finn more than a pair of pajamas-- it may cost him his friends!
