
Resilience and friendship are key themes in this delightful book, with its vibrant and endearing illustrations and flawless rhyme. It's a gem that's sure to be read over and over again.











Survey outcome

At the end of 2016 twenty-one thousand (21,000) Preschool Reading packs were provided free to South Australian children aged 4 years via their preschool. The reading packs contained 2 picture books, an activity book, a cookbook and a set of 5 mini meal picture books. In April of 2017, the South Australian Health department asked us to conduct a survey with the SA families and preschools who had received the preschool reading packs.

The response was very heartening with great reviews on the ease, attractiveness and reliability of Your Family's Favourite Cookbook and the cleverness of the 5 Mini Meal picture books. The response clearly demonstrates that the children and their families are using both the cookbook and mini meal picture books together to understand, plan and eat a wider and healthier range of foods. The two resources were carefully developed to encourage families and their children to have a better understanding of whole foods and how they convert into meals, for children to take ownership on what they want to eat and to have fun in the kitchen, together. We are very pleased to say that the two resources together are having great impact with families across SA.
