



But then I bump into an old friend at the school gates. She tells me that my college boyfriend Brad Dowling has woken up from his coma after five years.


No one ever thought he'd wake up - least of all me.

Maureen married young when she got pregnant. He could never stand the baby crying.


Shara's husband is a surgeon, a pillar of the community. But at home he's a monster.
