His commanding presence can silence a room or rattle a suspect, and his sharp instincts often put him a step ahead of his peers. Yeoman straddles the line between good cop and bad cop. His pursuit of justice often brings out his bad side, meaning he'll do whatever it takes to get results. But despite his never-ending supply of sarcastic quips mainly aimed at his team, deep down he's a kind man. He's fiercely protective of his team, but his stubborn nature often causes tension between them. Deep down there's a softer side to Yeoman that many don't get to see, except his beloved German Shepherd Rochester, who he adores. His personal life is complicated.
