SIMONE LAUDIERO Brancalonia

The novel that celebrates the Italian-style fantasy genre, aka the "Spaghetti Fantasy".

A ragtag group of actors is staging a wartime tragedy in the streets of Apollonia. After a particularly bad rehearsal, the penniless thespians walk around town in their soldier costumes hoping to scrape together some dinner. They end up in a tavern, where they get in a fight with a rival company of actors. Two outsiders, an old man and a young woman, watch the scuffle; after the costumed group gets the upper hand, they mistake them for real warriors and approach them. They offer to buy them dinner and, once they are seated at the table, they tell them their story. They come from a remote village in Macilento, a poor and rural region in Volturnia; they are looking for a group of noble-minded mercenaries to defend their little town from the threat of a gang of marauders in exchange for an honest pay. The actors have little doubt about it: they accept without even discussing it and commence their performance as men of arms. Once they get back to the dump where they are staying, they talk it over and come up with a plan: they will play the part, take the payment up front, and make a run for it before the bandits show up. Everyone knows that a dragon was killed in the area centuries ago and its treasure was never found. If they can figure out its location before the marauders' arrival, then they could get away with the jackpot. And so the adventure begins.

She inherits her father's bravery and virtue, but also a passion for culture: he was a great warrior and strategist who united all of Italy under his reign. She neglects feminine arts in favor of horseback riding and hunting trips with her servant Traguilla, who will soon make his way into her heart. The day Theodoric takes her with him to the Basilica of Sant'Apollinare in Ravenna, Amalasuintha is awestruck by the craftsmanship of the mosaic artists, whom her father had summoned all the way from Byzantium. She is her father's only offspring and sole heir to the throne, even though she will have to share it with a husband chosen for her by her father. But when that wedding takes place, Amalasuintha experiences it as a cruel punishment: she is relegated to the role of wife and mother, any chance of taking the reins from her father disappears, and she will also have to give up her forbidden romance. Until she is widowed: with her son too young to rule, she will be the one deciding the fate of the kingdom with the support of Justinian, the Eastern Roman emperor who holds her in high regard. But her subjects aren't ready to be ruled by a woman yet, and the court's plots will force her into an exile that will put an end to her dreams. Or, perhaps, it will be the beginning of a new life.

ORNELLA ALBANESE has written sixteen historical romance novels (published by the series I Romanzi Mondadori); two historical thrillers with a strong romantic component, *L'anello di ferro* and the award-winning *L'oscuro mosaico* (ed. Leggereditore); and, lastly, *Il sigillo degli Acquaviva* (ed. Leone Editore). Her latest historical novel *Il falconiere dei re* was published by Mondadori.

SARA PURPURA Origami Thief

Two rebellious kids from families connected to the mob grow up and fall in love in Palermo's working-class neighbourhoods.

Marco and Sofia's love story is set in Sicily, or rather in the working-class and roughest parts of Palermo where many kids have a very hard time growing up without falling for the lure of the mob. Marco and Sofia start having feelings for one another when they are still children; but the intense feeling they share for each other feels forbidden from the very beginning: she is the sister of Marco's best friend, and he would certainly see their relationship as a betrayal. Thus, from the very start, their love will therefore collide against a hostile reality, which worsens when she is sexually assaulted by a relative; her family decides to send her away instead of punishing the perpetrator. When she returns to her Palermo after two long years, she will have to reconnect with her past life and her first love, who has profoundly changed in the meantime. An intense and moving book about a passionate love story like only certain first loves can be.



This novel follows the story of Francesca as she slowly turns into Francesco, interwoven with the story of his very special relationship with Sara, whose presence (as well as her absence) has always left a deep mark on him ever since they were young. Sara, indeed, will become his great love and, above all, the person who accompanies him on his journey of self-discovery all the way to its most challenging phase: coming out and beginning his path to transition. A novel that can be at times very crude, but also full of love and tenderness. Like the unconditional love of Grandma Gioli, the powerful love he feels for Sara, and the self-love that Francesco has to build for himself. The story told by Cicconetti, which mixes elements from his real life with fictional bits, is certainly a unique and special tale of individual transformation, but it is also a universal story: a metaphor of the fight that we all engage in to discover who we really are and how to be ourselves to the fullest.

In reality, Giulia often disappears, mainly to avoid dealing with her parents' constant arguments, a sister with whom she's lost the close bond they once had, or the pain of being bullied or ignored by her classmates. Luckily, there's the Challenger, a gaming bar where she can escape and immerse herself in her favorite pastime: playing League of Legends. It's a safe haven hidden from the rest of the world where no one judges her or tells her how she should act or feel.

Even though Giulia is just an amateur player, she's remarkably skilled, and one day, she gets a chance to participate in a tournament that catches the attention of a prestigious gaming academy's staff. They make her an offer that's hard to refuse. However, accepting it isn't easy for Giulia. It would mean turning her solitary hobby, shared with strangers for a few minutes during a game, into something serious. And, most importantly, it would require her to share everything with her team. But maybe it's time for her to summon the courage she has and confront her fears, trusting the instincts she's often doubted. Perhaps it's time to look toward the future without being paralyzed by fear, at least for once.





These are just some of the most common questions in the ongoing conversation between teachers and parents, especially when their children are very young and experiencing nursery school or kindergarten for the first time. In this book aimed specifically at parents, the teachers from Reggio Children try to answer many predicaments, from the simplest to the most complex, faced by every parent who has their child's wellbeing at heart. This conversation between parents and teachers is aimed at supporting the life path of families raising children.




