

Tokyo Rose—Zero Hour tells the true story of Iva Toguri, a Japanese American woman who was visiting her relatives in Tokyo shortly before the attack on Pearl Harbor. Trapped in Japan, Iva refused to renounce her American citizenship. But she was forced to take a job with *Radio Tokyo* to host

"Zero Hour," a propaganda broadcast aimed at demoralizing American troops—in the role of the infamous Tokyo Rose, "The Siren of the Pacific."

The dramatic events recounted in this story include:

- **Iva's arrest by the Americans, who initially found that her actions were blameless**
- **Her emotional return to the United States and the racially-motivated public outcry that led to her re-arrest and prosecution for treason**
- **The dishonest actions of prosecutors who coerced witnesses into providing false evidence against her**
- **The six years she spent in prison, and her eventual pardon by President Ford in 1977**

This graphic novel includes an introduction explaining the "Tokyo Rose" phenomenon and the devastating effects that World War II had on Asian American communities that continue to this day. In a world rife with misinformation and prejudice, this story has never been more relevant!

Andre R. Frattino has devoted his life to the art of visual storytelling. Following his graduation from Savannah College of Art and Design, Andre went on to publish four graphic novels including *Simon Says: Nazi Hunter Volume 1* and *A Land Remembered: A Graphic Novel*.

Kate Kasenow is a comic artist with undergraduate and graduate degrees in Sequential Art from Savannah College of Art and Design. She has worked on an array of published graphic novels including *An Elegy for Amelia Johnson*, *Amy Devlin Mystery* and *Form of a Question*, a creative autobiography of a Jeopardy champion.

Janice Chiang is an award-winning comic letterer with over four decades of experience. She began her career as a freelancer for Marvel Comics and continues to work for all the major comic book publishers. Presently, she heads the lettering department for John and Sandy King Carpenter's Storm King Comics and is a freelancer for DC Comics.



Tales of Korea is a classic collection of Korea's best-known folktales—presenting all the imagination and wonder of Korean storytelling in a single volume. - “Charan” – A beautiful dancing girl befriends a governor’s son. As their friendship blossoms into love, their lives take an unexpected and agonizing turn!
- “Ten Thousand Devils” – A prince welcomes a distant relative for a visit only to discover that the guest controls thousands of evil creatures that converge on the prince’s home.
- “An Encounter with a Hobgoblin” – A man experiences horrifying visitations in his home and fears that he is living with a sinister force!
- “The Snake’s Revenge” – After a soldier kills a snake, the reptile is reborn as the man’s son and seeks revenge in a gruesome way!

This edition includes thirty full-color images which bring the magic and mystery of Korean folklore to life. A new foreword by Korean folklore expert Heinz Insu Fenkl explains how this fascinating collection of tales came to be published and its lasting importance today.

Im Bang, born in 1640, was a disciple of Song Si-yol, one of Korea's earliest known writers. In 1719, at the remarkable age of 79, he became Governor of Seoul and at the same time held office as secretary of the cabinet. His writings have long been revered in Korea and his reputation as a great scholar has endured for over three centuries.

Yi Ryuk lived during the reign of King Sejo (mid-15th century). The *Kuk-cho Inmul-chi* (Korea's Record of Famous Men) speaks of him as “a man of many offices and many distinctions in the ways of literary excellence.”

James S. Gale was a Presbyterian minister who arrived in Korea in 1888 to teach English and help translate the Bible into Korean. His books include *History of the Korean People* and a translation of *The Cloud Dream of the Nine*, the first work of Korean literature to be translated into English.

Heinz Insu Fenkl is an author, translator, educator and folklorist. He is Professor of English at SUNY New Paltz and sits on the editorial board of the journal *Azalea: Journal of Korean Literature and Culture*. His books include the novel *Memories of My Ghost Brother*, *Korean Folktales*, and *Kori: The Beacon Anthology of Korean American Literature*, which he edited.





Combining raw narrative power, pageantry and poetry, *The Heike Story* will enthrall readers interested in the drama and spectacle of ancient Japan.

Eiji Yoshikawa was born in Kanagawa, Japan. Despite receiving little more than a primary school education, he became Japan's most popular writer and authored some 80 novels and over 180 short stories. Credited with elevating popular fiction to an artform, Yoshikawa was the first writer of such works to be awarded the Imperial Order of Culture.

Fuki Wooyenaka Uramatsu was a writer, translator, editor and teacher. She was also a columnist for the English language *Yomiuri* newspaper.

Alexander Bennett is a professor of Japanese history and Budo theory at Kansai University. He cofounded and publishes *Kendo World*, the first English-language journal dedicated to Kendo. He holds black belts in several martial arts and his published works include *The Complete Musashi: The Book of Five Rings and Other Works* and *Hagakure: The Secret Wisdom of the Samurai*.



We got off at Miyajimaguchi Station. I was pleased to find the station stamp.


I stopped by the bathroom. When I sat down, a recording of rushing water and chirping played. It was like being in the middle of a pond.

The ferry was quick and pleasant. When we got off we immediately met some of the locals ...




"My dear," she said to her husband. "I don't feel too good and I've lost my appetite."
