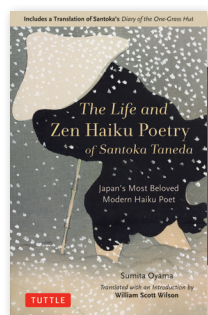

The poets include Bashō, Shiki, Buson and Issa (the "Great Four") along with other well-known practitioners of the genre such as Ryokan, Kikaku and Chora. Wilson provides many new renditions of poems that are already considered classics, and also includes the delightful work of poets who are rarely translated, including the female poets Chiyojo and Hisajo, as well as the famous novelist Natsume Sōseki, who, unbeknownst to many, also wrote haiku. An introduction is given for each poet, followed by a selection of that poet's most notable haiku. Audio recordings of the poems are available online in both English and Japanese.

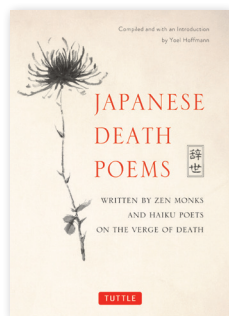

William Scott Wilson holds BAs from Dartmouth College and The Monterey Institute of Foreign Studies, and an MA from the University of Washington. He has worked as a translator and advisor on cultural affairs for the Japanese Consulate-General in Seattle, Washington; a teacher of Japanese language; and a guide for Japanese tourists in South Florida. He has published 20 books that have been translated into 21 foreign languages, including *The Lone Samurai: The Life of Miyamoto Musashi*. His translation of *Hagakure*, an 18th century treatise on samurai philosophy, was featured in the film *Ghost Dog*, by the director Jim Jarmusch. Wilson was awarded a Commendation from the Foreign Ministry of Japan, and inducted into the Order of the Rising Sun by the Japanese emperor.

Steven Heine is Professor of Religious Studies and History and Founding Director of the Asian Studies Program at Florida International University. A specialist on East Asian religions and society, especially the origins and development of Zen Buddhism in medieval Japan, Heine has published three dozen monographs and edited volumes. His most recent works include *From Chinese Chan to Japanese Zen*, *Readings of Dōgen's Treasury of the True Dharma Eye* and *Dōgen: Japan's Original Zen Teacher*.

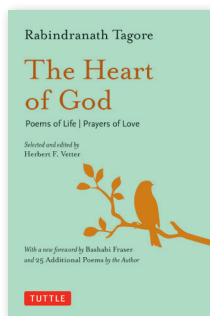

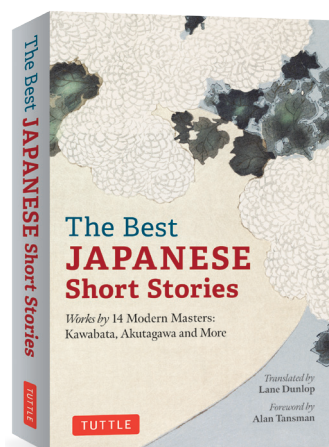

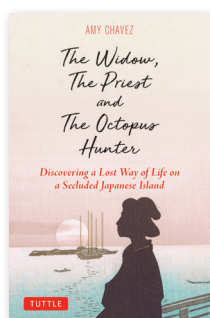

His translations include Kafu Nagai’s *During the Rains* & *Flowers in the Shade: Two Novellas* and Yasunari Kawabata’s *Palm-of-the-Hand Stories*.

Alan Tansman is Professor of Japanese in the Department of East Asian Languages and Cultures at the University of California, Berkeley. He is the author of *The Aesthetics of Japanese Fascism*, *The Writings of Kôda Aya: A Japanese Literary Daughter* and editor, with Dennis Washburn, of *Studies in Modern Japanese Literature: Essays and Translations in Honor of Edwin McClellan*.

Ihara Saikaku is regarded as Japan's first popular writer. The twenty stories in *This Scheming World* recount raucous events surrounding the New Year's Eve celebrations in Kyoto—as crafty money lenders attempt to collect money from equally crafty debtors. From the bawdy to the outrageous, these tales demonstrate how far people will go to avoid paying their debts—with unexpected, humorous and often disastrous results!

The finely-crafted tales in this collection include stories of:

- Philanderers who slip off to hide away in the homes of their mistresses
- Hustlers who leave town suddenly on “very important” business trips
- Connivers who become actors for a day, hiding in plain sight on the stage

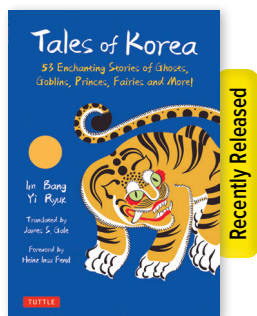
Ihara Saikaku (1641-1693) has been called “the greatest popular novelist of the 17th century.”

He began as a successful merchant in the up-and-coming city of Osaka. The tragedy of losing his wife and daughter moved him to abandon his business and become a wandering Buddhist monk, and for twenty years he wrote haiku verse and prose. Saikaku founded the Ukiyo-zoshi (“Floating World”) genre of literature which flourished in Japan between the 1680s and the 1770s.

Masanori Takatsuka, a graduate of Hiroshima Koshi, and **David C. Stubbs**, a graduate of Florida State University, were both faculty members of Kwansei Gakuin University in Nishinomiya, Japan.

David J. Gundry is Associate Professor of Japanese at the University of California, Davis. He has published numerous articles on Japanese literature as well as the book *Parody, Irony and Ideology in the Fiction of Ihara Saikaku*.

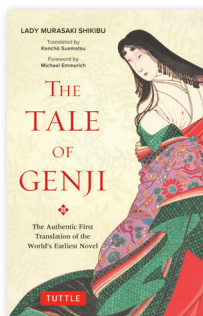

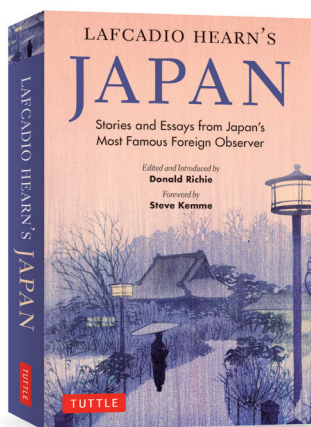

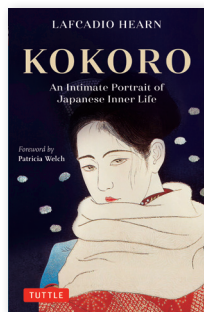
Lafcadio Hearn (1850-1904) was one of the earliest foreign writers to publish stories and essays about Japan in English. Arriving in 1890, he taught English literature and began publishing books on Japan in 1894, quickly becoming known as the most perceptive interpreter of all things Japanese to the West. His books include *Glimpses of Unfamiliar Japan*, *Kwaidan*, *Kokoro* and *In Ghostly Japan*.

Donald Richie (1924–2013) spent most of his life witnessing and reporting on the transformation of Japan from postwar devastation to economic powerhouse. He was the author of some forty books of fiction and nonfiction and hundreds of book, film, and arts reviews.

Steve Kemme is President of the Lafcadio Hearn Society (USA) and a former reporter for the *Cincinnati Enquirer*, where Hearn formerly worked. He is a member of the Japan Research Center of Greater Cincinnati and has spoken at Hearn symposiums worldwide.



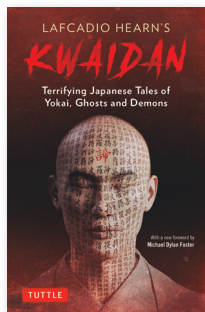

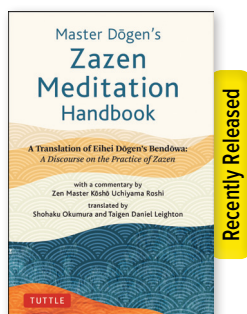
Blyth ultimately became the key link and mediator between the Imperial Household and the occupying American forces, whom many credit with saving Japan from chaos after the war. His fingerprints are everywhere today in the study of Zen, Haiku and Japanese culture, and his work has influenced some of the most important writers of the 20th century—including Huxley, Oshi, Aiken, Watts, Salinger, Kerouac, Ginsberg and others. He was, in many ways, a man who changed the world! *Mister Timeless Blyth* is his story.

Written in the form of an autobiographical novel filled with Zen and poetry, this book recounts a life of hard work, books and music, of spiritual questing, and of learning to be at peace with one's self and one's choices. It celebrates a man who built bridges between East and West for the greater part of his lifetime. Through it, we understand someone who moved through life with a sense of purpose, warmth and humor and left a mark that was very distinct indeed.

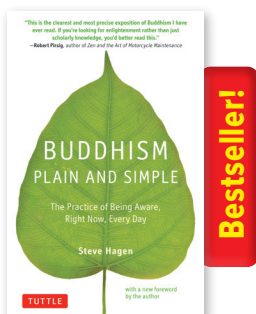
Alan Spence is an award-winning poet, playwright, novelist and short story writer. He has been named Scottish Writer of the Year and was awarded the People's Prize and Spirit of Scotland Award. He is Professor Emeritus in Creative Writing at Aberdeen University, and from 2017 to 2021 was Edinburgh Makar (Poet Laureate to the City). In 2018 he was awarded the Order of the Rising Sun from the Government of Japan. With his wife Janani he runs the Sri Chinmoy Meditation Centre in Edinburgh.



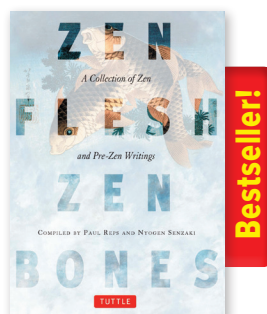

Grilled Beef Meatballs with Sweet Chili Dipping Sauce

One of my favorite street food spots is Luk Chin Anamai on Sornvijai Road, next to the hospital. I actually look forward to doctor visits because I know that I can go grab a bite at the noodle shop afterwards. While their beef noodles are very famous, this shop's meatballs are what I remember best. Unlike most diners who prefer ordering the finely milled, soft beef meatballs, I love the grilled tendler-y ones best and think this recipe replicates that texture well.

SERVES 4 PREP TIME: 30 MINUTES COOKING TIME: 30 MINUTES

2 cloves garlic
2 shallots
½ inch (1.3 cm) galangal, peeled
3 fresh lemongrass leaves, stems removed and finely sliced
1 tablespoon shaved palm sugar or white sugar
2 tablespoons potato starch
2 small fish's eye chilies
1 lb (pound) 450 g ground beef, the higher fat the better
1 egg
2 tablespoons fish sauce
1 tablespoon peanut oil
2 tablespoons soy sauce
For garnish lime wedges, to serve and cucumber leaves (optional)
Thai Sweet Chili Sauce (optional)

Thai Sweet Chili Sauce

4 finger-length red chilies (just chilies, also known as pili chilies as we use in Thailand)
3-5 red bird's eye chilies, or to taste
6-8 cloves garlic, peeled, or to taste
½ cup (95 ml) water
¼ cup (50 ml) shaved palm or white sugar
¼ cup (50 ml) white vinegar
1 tablespoon fish sauce
Salt, to taste
1 tablespoon potato starch (optional) or replace may be substituted dissolved in 3 tablespoons warm water



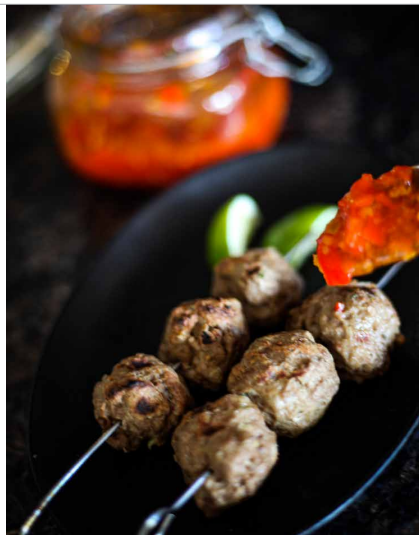
dinner for 3 minutes to let the flavors develop.

Whisk in the starch mixture and gently simmer for a few more minutes. Remove from the heat, taste and adjust seasoning as needed. Transfer into a jar and let cool.

Puree all the dry meatball ingredients in a food processor until it forms a paste. Then add the meat, egg, fish sauce, soy sauce and peanut oil and blend until fully incorporated and slightly fluffy. The mixture will be soft and sticky.

Take a medium-sized pot and fill halfway with water and bring to a simmer. Using very wet hands, scoop a slightly heaped tablespoon of the meatball mixture and roll between palms into a ball approx 1½ inch (3.75 cm) and then drop directly into the water careful not to splatter yourself. Push the meatballs for 2 minutes and remove from the water with a slotted spoon. Set aside on either a plate or wire rack.

Once the meatballs are not too hot to handle, place them on skewers and grill. Serve with the lime wedges, cucumber leaves and Thai Sweet Chili Sauce.
